Dear Faculty, Staff and Parents:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires that our school notify faculty, staff and parents of the presence and current status of asbestos containing materials in our school buildings. The law also requires a management plan be updated and available based upon the findings of our biannual inspections.

Aina Haina Elementary School performed the required biannual surveillances on 05/26/23 and on 11/03/23. The next required surveillance will be conducted on or before 06/01/24. All custodians at Aina Haina were retrained in AHERA management at the beginning of the 2023-24 school year. All new custodians were trained in AHERA management at the beginning of the 23-24 school year.

The results of the recently completed surveillance indicate that there have been no changes in the condition of current asbestos containing materials on campus.

A copy of the inspection report and the management plan is available for public review in the administration building office during normal business hours (7:30am – 4:00pm).
