As we move in to the 2nd quarter, parent teacher conferences and the holiday season, please be thoughtful of the following:

- We can never remind our child(ren) enough about precautions they can take when they are walking to or from school. Particularly, safely crossing of streets, being aware of their surroundings and immediately reporting any potentially inappropriate interactions with strangers to an adult.
- Drive with patience, courtesy and attention while on or around Aina Haina's campus.
