Did you know?

There are over 2,000 homeless students in Hawaii's public schools.

Children in elementary school will increase a slipper size at least 1-2 times a year.

Donated items will be distributed by the DOE's Community Engagement Branch

Guided by federal mandates of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, the DOE's Community Engagement Branch works with schools to ensure that identified students are given access to comparable services as provided to other students. The Office serves over 2,000 students who are faced with homelessness and limited access to simple necessities such as food, clothing and footwear, and often lose personal items as a result of their family's constant relocation. The donated footwear will provide students with supplemental items that may not always be available to them.
